

Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, March 18, 2026
Rock Creek Town Hall
7:00 PM

1. Rachel called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Board members present were Rachel Kummer, Jon Koller, Adam Biesterveld and Kelly Boardman. Dylan Panette, Rusty Kummer, Roy Splinter, Doug Anderson, Chad Ableidinger, Dave Plagnz and Jason Wiley also attended.

2. Jon made a motion to approve the February monthly meeting minutes. Adam seconded the motion. Vote taken, Three in favor, zero opposed and zero abstained.

3. Jon made a motion to approve the January treasurer's report. Adam seconded. Vote was taken, Three in favor and zero opposed, zero abstained.

4. Jon made a motion to approve the financial report for January. Adam seconded. Vote taken, Three in favor, zero opposed and zero abstained.

5. Jon made a motion to provisionally approve the treasurers' report for February. Adam seconded. Vote was taken, Three were in favor and zero opposed and zero abstained.

6. Jon made a motion to provisionally accept the Financial Report for February. Adam seconded. Vote taken, all in favor and zero opposed and zero abstained.

7. Report from the Chair:

- Sherriff called and had 2 stray dogs, owners were found
- Weight ban signs will be added at all Brunswick township town lines.
- Dylan ordered new posts as many are rotten and need replacement
- DOT award of damages was for the highway 85 project for the road that is platted through Luer's store. Currently the money is sitting with the county.
- Post Heffernan hill as a Class B road from 180th Ave. to Cty Road O. narrow road signs will also be posted.
- Conrads and Rachel Kummer applied for a weight permit for Conrads Road and 810th St.

8. Road bids for 110th Ave. Were opened. Monarch Paving and Senn Black Top submitted road bids. The bids were to be submitted in 1/2, 3/4 and 1 mile increments.

Jon made a motion to award Project 3, the full mile of 110th Ave., to Monarch Paving. Adam seconded. Three in favor, zero opposed and zero abstained.

9. Road damages and culverts:

- Culverts to be replaced on 810th by Hwy 85, 810th St by Talford/Kummer Farm, and by Conrads.
- 810th st had shoulder work done and was billed to Bentin Dairy.
- 90th and 810th will have sections of the road cut out and replaced due to damages.

- Field road by Dan Falkner will be repaired and billed to RDO
- Billy Rinholen will be contacted to get his field roads up to code to prevent damages.
- Land owner damaged the North Road and will need to fix near his driveway.

10. Road Inspections will be held March 30, 2026 at 5:00PM

11. Transportation Funding Resolution:

Jon made a motion to adopt Resolution R2026-03-01 Transportation Funding Resolution. Adam seconded the motion. Vote was taken, all in favor and zero opposed.

12. Jon made a motion to send the Town of Albany the 2026 Fire Contract. Adam seconded the motion. Vote was taken, all in favor and zero opposed.

13. Jon made a motion to approve the Solid Waste Ordinance O2020-10-15 (Rev 2026-03-18) Adam seconded the motion. Vote was taken, all in favor and zero opposed.

14. Public Comments:

- Doug would like the town to abandon 919th St., (Freemont St) on the South side, the dead end by his home.
- Doug has the material to rebuild the pavilion by the bridge. He would like to have a light placed in the area as it was removed when the bridge was redone.
- Roy asked that the town sweep River Ridge Estates to remove the excess sand.
- Huftel will also be swept.
